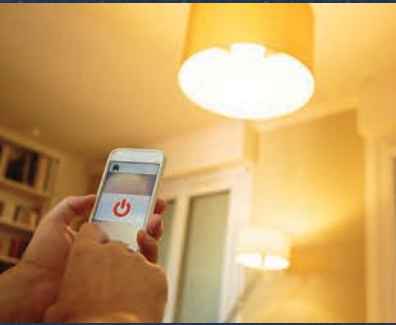

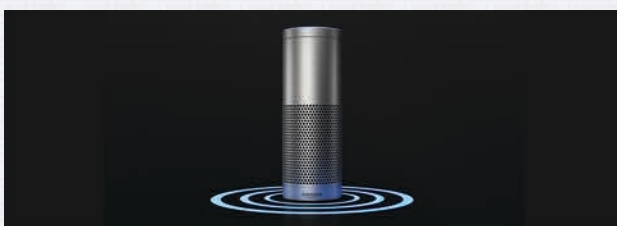
Smart Home or Automated Home

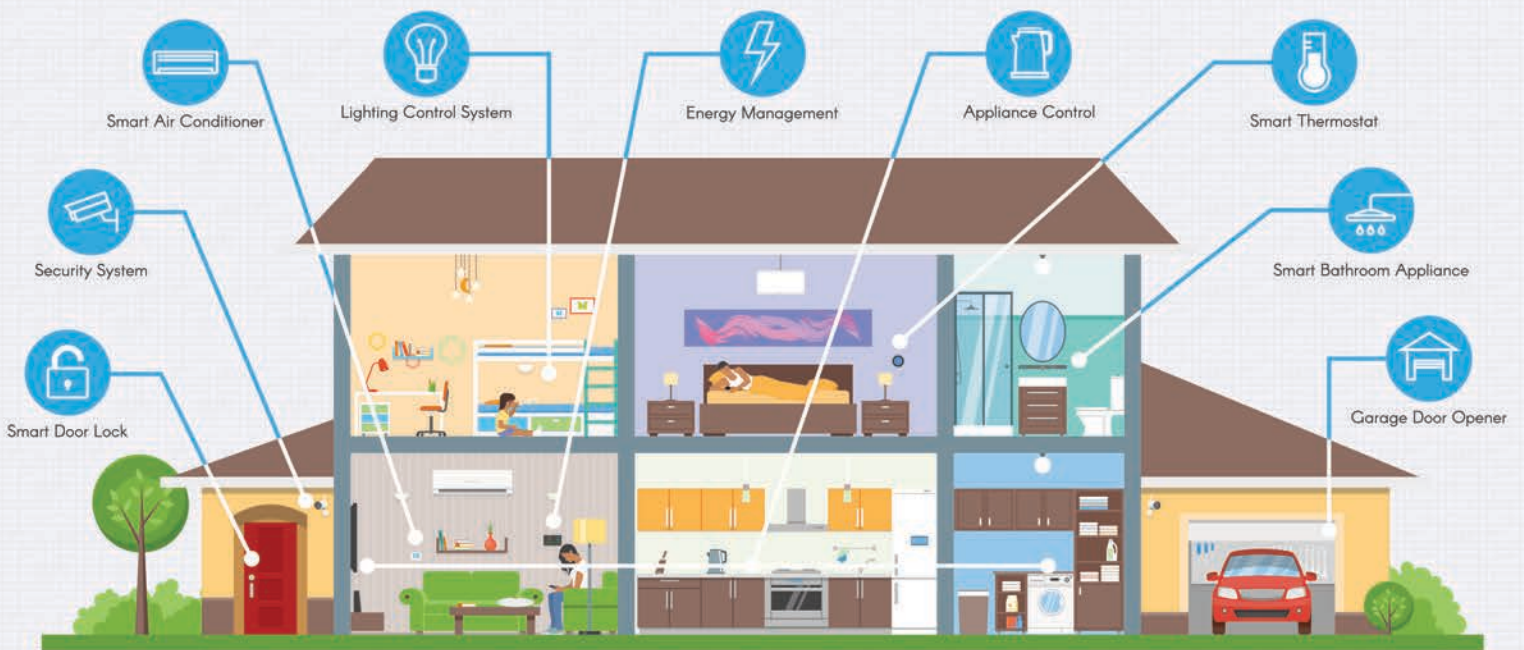

Garage Door Opener

Smart Air Conditioner
